CLUBS AND COMMITTEES

Residents at Edgehill actively participate in the community through the various clubs and committees offered both on and off campus.

Activities Committee

Works with associates on ideas for resident programs and activities and helps support campus activities.

Appreciation Fund

Organizes bi-annual monetary donations to be divided equally among all employees.

Food Committee

Meets with the food and beverage director and executive chef to provide resident feedback, plan special dining events and discuss menu changes.

Grounds Committee
